We, Jennings O'Donovan & Partners Limited (JOD), on behalf of our client, Inchamore Wind Designated Activity Company, hereby submit a planning application to Kerry County Council for works in the townland of Derryreag Co. Kerry associated with the proposed Inchamore Wind Farm project in County Cork.

A planning application has been lodged with Cork County Council in relation to the elements of the project that are within the townlands of Inchamore, Milleeny and Derreenaling, Co. Cork. The development in Cork includes five wind turbines, underground cabling, site access roads, a borrow pit, a temporary site compound, a 38 kV substation and all associated works for which a ten-year planning permission is being sought.
